### **CHAPTER-IV**

# STATUS OF MEDICAL COLLEGE LIBRARIES IN MAHARASHTRA

# 4.1 Introduction:

Maharashtra state is in the western region of India. It is the second most populated after Uttar Pradesh and third largest state by area in India. Maharashtra is one of the wealthy states in India, It is also at the fore front in health care development in the country, better than other states .So many medical colleges are functioning in good condition in major cities of Maharashtra like Pune, Mumbai and Nagpur. Pune University at Pune is called 'Oxford the of East'. The Southwest districts of Maharashtra like Pune, Ahamadnagar, Kolhapur, Sangli, Solapur and Satara are well developed in education . These all District are well developed in education.

All types of education are available here—such as engineering, Medical, arcthitecture, Dental etc run under under state government, central government and private sectors.


# 4.2 Status of Medical College Libraries in Maharashtra:

The medical colleges are developed under medical council of India, Delhi. The Medical Council of India upgrades and evalutes all the colleges and gives as to sugestion how to improvement teaching staff, varies infrastucture, facilites and so on. There are six division in Maharashtra such as Amravati, Aurangabad, Konkan, Nagpur, Nashik and Pune.

The 42 medical colleges and libraries are situated in this region. Larger no of medical colleges libraries are in Pune, Mumbai and Nagpur. 17 medical college are under the state Government, 2 medical colleges and libraries are under the Municipal Corporation and only o1 medical college is under the central Government. While rest of them about 22 medical college are under private institutes. Larger no of medical colleges libraries are in Pune, Mumbai and Nasik division. Every year 4910 students are admitted in the first year batch of Allopathic Medical College in Maharashtra. Total number of undergraduate students are 14730, postgraduates are 3775, research student 679 and over all Maharashtra total medical library user are 19184 students. All the medical colleges are affiliated to respective local universities

and Health University at Nasik. Every year Medical Council of India (M.C.I) observe upgrading and improvement of all facilities, availability of qualified staff and students services. Library is main soul of medical college. so medical library must be upgrade for student satisfaction.




Fig. No. 4.1: No. of Medical Colleges in Konkan Division




Fig. No. 4.2: No. of Medical Colleges in Pune Division




Fig. No. 4.3: Number of Medical Colleges in Amravati Division




Fig. No. 4.4: No. of Medical College in Nasik Division




Fig. No. 4.5: No. of Medical Colleges in Aurangabad Division




Fig. No. 4.6: No. of Medical Colleges in Nagpur Division




Fig. No. 4.7: Division wise Percentage of Medical College in Maharashtra




Fig. No. 4.8: Users in Pune Division




Fig. No. 4.9: Konkan Division




Fig. No. 4.10: Nagpur Division




Fig. No. 4.11: Nasik Division




Fig. No. 4.12: Districtwise Library Users in Aurangabad Division




Fig. No. 4.13: Amravati Division





Fig. No. 4.14: Total Library User


